
What Database Am I Using?

FMS has several databases used for different purposes. When you are doing *real* work you should be using the Production database. This is known as **fmsprd** and its URL is

`http:fms/fmsprd`

You may also reach the production web site by using a shortcut. Just type **epro** in the URL. This shortcut goes to the same place as the formal URL.

You can easily check which database you are in by checking the URL. In the example below you can see the production database name.



If you are using a bookmark to get to the production database, check to be sure it is pointing to the correct database.

Other databases:

- fmstrn – This is the training database and is generally used only in the training room. The URL is fms/fmstrn.
- fmsdev – Developer’s database. This is for FMS developer’s use only.
- fmsbox – If you want to practice using FMS use this database. The URL is fms/fmsbox.
- fms8box – This was a database used prior to our going live with FMS 8.8. It should no longer be used. This database go away by July month end.
